ITC Account and SFC-CNS Account

You can use an ITC account to use PCs, printers, networks, etc. installed on each campus. And on the Shonan Fujisawa Campus, you use a SFC-CNS account.

Integrated Printing System

You can request printing from a PC installed on any campus or a PC in your home, and have it printed at any printer you choose installed on the campus. When printing, you settle accounts using your IC card used for paying transportation fares.

Network Connection

At Keio, you can use wired LAN connection and wireless LAN (WiFi) connection services. And you can use eduroam (international wireless LAN roaming service).

Software and GakuNin System

Software

Keio University has contracted site licenses for office software, image editing software, numerical processing software, statistical analysis software, plagiarism prevention software, OS, and others which it supplies to students and faculty in order to develop educational and research activities.

GakuNin System

Keio University Academic Access Management Federation (GakuNin) System allows you to use services compatible with GakuNin by logging in using your Keio account. It provides e-journals, e-learning systems, file sharing systems, and software development tools and other services.

User Support

Services that ITC provides include not only preparing various user manuals; it has also set up user consultation counters for students and faculty to resolve users' problems.

Rental PCs

At the Mita, Hiyoshi, Shinanomachi, and Shonan Fujisawa Campuses, students can rent a note-PC. The rental PC permits the use of many kinds of software that Keio University has licensed.

Public Relations Activities

ITC not only actively supplies information about the provision of the information environment, but about information security and copyright protection, mainly for each year's new students and newly appointed faculty.
